#### Materion Trafodwyd -Matters discussed

Discussion around that we are lucky that the community has a new modern and updated Park for the village on a secure safe site less than a 2-minute walk away. A site visit with the councilors to be arranged. Moving forward with a more greener and diverse approach with

De-fib pads were replaced on both the Rhydypennau Hall and Spar, with exp dates of 02/2026.

Complaint from the framer that the bins in Bryncastell Park were overflowing into his fields to Cllr.P.Hinge were actioned immediately and seen to by Cllr.E.Morgan who ensured there were no further rubbish that could harm animals and extra checks were put in place to review the bins by herself.
